## Rules

The following changes have been made to the normal EASFA Cup rules.

### Match Duration

| Year 8  | 20 minutes E/W | A total of 10 minutes has been allocated in the scheduling of each match to include half time and injury time. |
| Year 9  | 25 minutes E/W |  |
| Year 10 | 30 minutes E/W |  |
| Year 11 | 35 minutes E/W |  |
| Year 12 | 40 minutes E/W |  |

However, due to time constraints each game will have **NO EXTRA TIME** and instead draws at full time in **EVERY** final will be decided by penalties.

Space around the pitch at Seaview is limited. Teams are permitted to warm up on the **opposite side** of the pitch to the dug outs while games are being played. Disruption to the match should be minimal.

Schools should ensure their team is ready to start for the allocated KO time and no excuses will be accepted for **delaying the match fixtures**. Teams in the Year 9 final should arrive at their discretion, however must be ready to **start for the 10am KO**.

Schools should note that Seaview is providing **changing facilities\*\*\*** to help encourage a full day event. Each final will use alternate changing rooms to enable the smooth and continual match schedule. Home and away changing rooms are allocated as per each final fixture.

**Official match footballs** will be provided for each final, however teams can also bring their own for their own usage.

**Official and neutral referees** will be provided for each final, however schools should be prepared to assist as lines person if necessary.

\*All teachers are responsible for ensuring that pupils wear appropriate footwear. No exceptions and failure to do so will result in pupils not being allowed to play. **NO METAL STUDS** are allowed on the pitch. **TRAINERS or RUBBER BLADES & STUDS ONLY.**

\*\*All players, pupils and spectators are the responsibility of the schools they are representing at all times throughout the day.

\*\*\*Schools are responsible for contacting their opposition and ensuring there is no issues such as kit clashes.
